Customising **Window Captions**

Did you know that you can edit your Window Captions to permanently display useful data, such as Impact Version, Drawing Code or Customer Name?




1. The default **Window Captions** displayed

when a project is open, are as follows:

Impact - ADMIN - [Display book stand (Project): 1 Outside viewed as Outside]

2. If you go to **Options>Environment> Environment> Window Captions** (subject to user-privileges)



You can edit the Project Title...

Window Caption Formats <%DRAWING NAME> (<%DRAWING TYPE>): <%WINDOW ID> <%ACTUAL FACE> viewed as <%VIEWED FACE> Project Title:

...as follows: <%DRAWING_TYPE>: <%DRAWING_NAME> - Code: <%DRAWING_ CODE> - Customer: <%[CUSTOMER.CS NAME]> - Window: <%WINDOW_ID> <%ACTUAL_FACE> viewed as <%VIEWED_FACE>

4. You can also edit the **Main Title**...

<%PRODUCT> - <%USER> Main Title:

...as follows: <%PRODUCT><%VERSION_NAME>

5. This will result in... Window Caption Formats <%DRAWING TYPE>; <%DRAWING NAME> - Code; <%DRAWING CODE> - Customer; <%ICUSTOMER.CS NAME|> - Window; <%WINDOW ID> <%A</p> <%PRODUCT><%VERSION NAME>

6. Which forces Impact to display the following...

O Impact2019 R2 Service Pack 1 - [Project: Display book stand - Code: P000020 - Customer: Arden Software UK Ltd - Window: 1 Outside viewed as Outside]

7. You can now see at-a-glance, the **Impact Version Number**, plus the **Project Code** and **Assigned** Customer, without checking the Database menu or Database tab of the Impact Explorer.

Note: There are also many more items you can make use of, as below:

Substitutions: <%s>, where s = USER, VERSION, VERSION_NAME, PRODUCT, APPLICATION_NAME, DRAWING_CODE, DRAWING_NAME, DRAWING_TYPE, WINDOW_ID, LAYER, ACTUAL_FACE, VIEWED_FACE, DIE_FACE or any database column enclosed in square brackets for example [LAYERS.L_CODE].
